Grant Opportunities and Updates

[NSF | Accelerating Research Translation program](#) **Webinar on Tuesday, Feb. 21, 2023, 2-3 p.m. ET.** The U.S. National Science Foundation today announced the Accelerating Research Translation, or ART, program, a new \$60 million investment led by NSF's Directorate for Technology, Innovation and Partnerships. The program will support institutions of higher education to build capacity and infrastructure needed to strengthen and scale the translation of basic research outcomes into impactful solutions and practice. The ART program seeks proposals that have a blend of: Activities that will help develop and strengthen institutional infrastructure to build and sustainably grow the institutional capacity for research translation in the short and long terms. Educational and training opportunities — especially for graduate students and postdoctoral researchers — to enable individuals to become entrepreneurs and/or seek use-inspired and translational research-oriented careers in the public and private sectors. Specific translational research activities that show significant promise for translating research results to practice in the short term.

[Evaluation on Domestic Radicalization and Violent Extremism](#) **Webinar on Tuesday, Feb. 21, 2023, 1:00 – 2:00 p.m. ET.**

This webinar will give an overview of NIJ's Research and Evaluation on Domestic Radicalization and Violent Extremism solicitation. With this solicitation, NIJ seeks proposals for rigorous research and evaluation projects targeted toward developing a better understanding of the domestic radicalization phenomenon, and advancing evidence-based strategies for effective intervention and prevention. [Department of Energy | EXPRESS Exploratory Research for Extreme Scale Science](#) *FOA Attached **Pre-Application Deadline: March 8, 2023.** Extreme-scale science recognizes that disruptive technology changes are occurring across science applications, algorithms, computer architectures and ecosystems. Proposed research should not focus strictly on a specific science use case, but rather on creating the body of knowledge and understanding that will inform future advances in extreme-scale science. Exploratory Research for Extreme-Scale Science (EXPRESS) opportunities exist for the following research topics: Modeling Future Supercomputing Systems, Programming Techniques for Computational Physical Systems, Quantum Algorithms across Models. The maximum and minimum award size are dependent on how applicants and their team members.

[CDC-RFA-DP-23-0013 The High Obesity Program \(HOP\)](#) **Deadline: March 21, 2023, by 11:59 PM ET.** The High Obesity Program (HOP). Poor nutrition and low levels of physical activity affect overall health and are significant risk factors for obesity and other chronic diseases. This five-year program will fund land grant universities to leverage community extension services to implement evidence-based strategies that improve nutrition, safe and accessible physical activity, including family health weight and early care and education programs in counties with an adult obesity rate of over 40%. It will carry out activities that can inform future state and local level programmatic efforts and provides continued support to achieve optimal health for all Americans. Funding amount: from \$500K to \$1.2M.

[J.M. Kaplan | Alice Award](#) **Deadline: April 1, 2023.** An award of \$25,000 will be given to a richly illustrated book that contributes to its field and demonstrates high production standards. Books selected by the award jury for the shortlist will receive

\$5,000. The award is intended to buttress the slow reading movement that recognizes and cherishes the lasting values of the well-made illustrated book and the special sense of intimacy it affords. Fields considered include the fine arts and the natural and built environments, and related public issues.

[CDC-RFA-IP-23-0001 Promoting, Strengthening and Enhancing Disease Prevention through Collaboration with Targeted Partnerships](#) **Deadline: April 7, 2023, by 11:59 PM ET.** This opportunity focuses on communication and education activities to promote and maintain accurate information about vaccines across the lifespan among partners and the general public. It will also fill the need to educate the United States Department of Agriculture Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (USDA/WIC) staff about the latest vaccine recommendations and best practices to facilitate vaccination referrals to participants. This project is intended to decrease missed opportunities to provide important information to targeted partnerships including those who build vaccine confidence, achieve health equity, and increase engagement with trusted messengers across the lifespan. Funding amount: varies.

[CDC-RFA-DP-23-0014 Racial and Ethnic Approaches to Community Health \(REACH\)](#) **Deadline: April 11, 2023, by 11:59 PM. ET.** This 5-year program is to improve health, prevent chronic diseases, and reduce health disparities among racial and ethnic populations with the highest risk, or burden, of chronic disease. Supporting culturally tailored interventions to address to promote activities to decrease tobacco use, poor nutrition practices, and physical inactivity. Supporting implementation, evaluation, and dissemination of practice- and evidence-based strategies of tobacco, nutrition, and physical activity collaborations that ultimately lead to reduced health disparities in chronic conditions of hypertension, heart disease, Type 2 diabetes, and obesity. Supporting activities to enhance capacity to educate and promote the importance of immunization among racial and ethnic minority populations. Linking community and clinical efforts to increase individual's access to health care and preventive care programs within their community. Funding amount: from \$100K to \$150K.

[O-NIJ-2023-171566 NIJ FY23 Research and Evaluation on Firearms Violence and Mass Shootings](#) **Deadline: May 4, 2023.** NIJ seeks applications for funding of research and program evaluation projects that inform efforts to prevent and reduce intentional, interpersonal firearm violence and mass shootings in the United States in two categories: (1) research or evaluation of Extreme Risk Protection Order (ERPO) laws, otherwise known as "Red Flag Laws" and (2) research on the sources of the firearm used in the commission of a crime and the relationship of those sources to shootings and gun-related violence. Funding amount: varies by Category.

[O-NIJ-2023-171586 NIJ FY23 Research and Evaluation on Violence Against Women](#) **Deadline: May 10, 2023.** Funding to support the development of objective and independent knowledge and validated tools to reduce violence against women, promote justice for victims of crime, and enhance criminal justice responses. This program furthers the DOJ's mission by supporting the development of new knowledge and tools to address the challenges of crime and justice in the United States through fundamental research. Funding amount: varies.
